EDI events in 2025 so far

2025 has been a landmark year for the Leasing Foundation's EDI group. In March, we held a powerful session on championing inclusion and accessibility in the workplace, bringing together voices from across the sector to share real experiences and practical steps for creating supportive environments. The event was a reminder that accessibility and well-being are essential to inclusion, not an afterthought.

Also in March, across <u>Women's History Month and the International Women's Day (IWD)</u>, we repeated last year's hugely successful spotlight series on inspirational women from the industry – now a flagship initiative for us. Each working day of the month, we shone a spotlight on a female industry colleague who shared her reflections on lessons learned to date. All 25 participants role modelled this year's IWD theme of #AccelerateAction.

In July, we made history as 50 colleagues from across the industry joined us for the first-ever coordinated <u>Pride march</u> for the asset finance sector. Walking from Hyde Park Corner to Westminster alongside over 35,000 others, we showed that our industry is serious about visibility, allyship and standing in solidarity with LGBTQ+ colleagues.

We also hosted our first event for <u>South Asian Heritage Month</u>. The evening featured a panel of inspiring speakers sharing their lived experiences of identity, representation and inclusion, followed by open networking. It was honest, celebratory and thought-provoking in equal measure.

These events reflect what the EDI group is all about - creating safe, meaningful spaces for conversation, raising awareness and sparking change. Together, they've helped build stronger networks and moved our industry one step closer to being truly inclusive.



Future work and focus on gender

What does it really mean to be a woman working in asset finance? That was the focus of <u>Defining Moments</u>, our virtual September event which heard from women at different stages of their careers about the decisions, trade-offs and challenges that have shaped their paths.

The event went beyond surface-level stories to look at the barriers women face and how to navigate them. Following a panel discussion, we moved into breakout sessions where everyone discussed their own views and experiences.

It's simple, fun and free. And it's one of the most effective ways we've found to connect people across the industry. For more information and to sign up, <u>click here</u>


